Ready to share your knowledge and help other students launch their banking careers? Become an RMA Campus Ambassador for the 2019 fall semester!

RMA Campus Ambassadors are students passionate about pursuing a commercial banking as a career. Ambassadors display strong leadership and organizational skills, the ability to connect with peers, and enthusiasm for careers in commercial banking.

Campus Ambassadors will be responsible to achieve four **PRIMARY OBJECTIVES**:

1. Build awareness and recruiting of RMA Student members and Academic members for educators on your campus
2. Build awareness and encourage participation in RMA scholarship opportunities
3. Increase the visibility of RMA and careers in banking on your campus through hosting an event
4. Strengthen ties between the local RMA chapter and your school through communications

BENEFITS:

- Resume builder
- Campus Ambassadors will receive a monetary stipend
- Opportunities to earn bonuses based on optional duties
- Networking with banking professionals from the local RMA chapter
- Opportunities to be appointed for a full academic year as a campus ambassador after satisfactory completion of a semester term
- Free admittance to RMA NE chapter events

REQUIREMENTS:

- RMA Member (Student Membership is Free. Sign up if not already a member.)
- Sophomore, junior, or senior attending a four-year college or university that is an RMA academic partner
- Declared business related major or minor and the intention to pursue a career in banking
- 3.0 GPA or above

- One essay on why you want to become a commercial banker (no more than 250 words)
- One recommendation letter from a faculty member
- Complete web-based RMA training

COMPENSATION:

Ambassadors will receive a \$250 stipend per semester, for approximately 10 hours of work. In order to receive the stipend, all ambassadors must complete the following:

1. Recruit a minimum of 10 Students or Academic RMA members
2. Hold/Organize one event related to commercial banking on the school campus (with support from the local RMA chapter)
3. Document activity and submit a report at the end of the term
4. Educate and encourage participation in the RMA scholarship program

In addition to completing the four deliverables required of all campus ambassadors, ambassadors are eligible for an additional stipend of up to \$250 in total for completing the following optional assignments:

- \$100 bonus
 - Identify a potential ambassador successor
 - Attend and bring 3 or more students to an RMA New England Chapter event (or RMA Chapter Young Professionals event)
 - Submit an article for publication at your school's newspaper, or RMA New England chapter newsletter
- \$50 for every additional 10 student and/or academic memberships
- \$25 per scholarship application (with referral noted on application)
